The Fresno Metropolitan Flood Control District is currently recruiting for an **Engineer III, R.C.E.** The current vacancy is in the Development Review Division of the Engineering Department. Duties may include review and interpret the District's Master Plan, storm drainage plans, grading plans, utility plans, and basin designs. Interpret various maps and plans to determine site conditions. Interpret project specifications as well as the District's Standard Drawings and Specifications. Perform and review Hydraulic & Hydrology plan layouts for District facilities and proposed future revisions. Prepare reports, agreements, correspondence, maps, and associated materials for public agencies, developers, contractors, District staff, and the District's Board of Directors. Support District management with solutions to engineering-related problems and questions. Communicate with public and private engineering departments and regulatory agencies related to the District's programs, Master Plan, design standards, and Standard Plans and Specifications. Supervise day-to-day activities of subordinate staff; to include interviewing, training, developing, assigning, and reviewing work, evaluating and disciplining subordinate staff and communicating policy and objectives to staff. Represents the District at meetings and conferences with other agencies, private developers, and the public regarding coordination of proposals related to drainage and flood control. Performs other related engineering duties as needed.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

The position requires a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering or related degree, specialization in hydraulics and hydrology preferred. Registration with the State of California as a Civil Engineer is required. **Engineer III, R.C.E.**, requires five (5) years' experience in civil engineering work with special familiarity with storm drainage and flood control systems design, operations, and construction, including at least two (2) years' experience at a level to commensurate with the District's Engineer II position. One year of which must have been in a supervisory capacity over professional engineering staff. A valid California Driver License is required.
